Presentation Student Exch. Programme

Jasper students Caleb Catto, Walter Ostrander, together with Japanese student Jasper/Hakone Mei Takahashi were present at the Council meeting. The Jasper students gave a brief update on their recent trip to Hakone, Japan, outlining some of the activities they had undertaken. Mei Takahashi is visiting Jasper as part of the Jasper/Hakone Student Exchange programme. Ms. Takahashi will be in Canada until August 27th when she will return to her university studies in Hakone.

> The Jasper/Hakone Student Exchange Programme is offered each year to students of Jasper's grade 11 who believe they will be a true ambassador for Jasper in Japan. Students are chosen on the basis of a written essay.

The costs of the programme are mostly borne by local service clubs – Jasper Lions Club and Jasper Rotary Club. The Jasper/Hakone Student Exchange Programme has been in existence for the past 42 years and well over 100 students have taken part in the Programme.

Presentation Falon Gong

Council received a brief presentation from representatives of Falon Gong, who were travelling around the country, requesting support for Falon Gong practitioners and raising awareness of the persecution of Falon Gong practitioners by the Chinese Government.
