Call to Order	Councillor Kelleher-Empy called the meeting to order at 9:31 am.

Councillor Damota	Councillor Damota joined the meeting at 9:51 am.
Speed Limits and Signage	<p>Council discussed various aspects of speed limits and signage, including safety enhancements, crosswalks and sign pollution.</p> <p>After a review of options 1 through 3 as presented in the agenda, council agreed to eliminate options 1 and 2 as possible outcomes for speed limits in Jasper. Council requested blank maps, which will enable each councillor to create their own options. Each councillors' map will be presented at the next committee of the whole meeting.</p> <p>Councillors also requested that winter use of sidewalks for cyclists be discussed at a future meeting.</p>
Recess	Councillor Kelleher-Empy called a recess from 10:43 am to 10:51 am.
Stan Wright Parking Lot	<p>Council discussed draft design plans for the Stan Wright Parking Lot. Some councillors noted the current configuration of the parking lot could be limiting; and inquired about the intended use of this parking lot (public parking, commercial parking, RV parking, etc.).</p> <p>Administration will return with more information on this item at the next committee of the whole meeting.</p>
Other new business	Councillor Damota reiterated that winter use of sidewalks for cyclists should be discussed at a future meeting; councillors also discussed the logistics of implementing an "Idaho Stop", which allows cyclists to yield at a stop sign rather than come to a complete stop.
