Information Update Jasper Intergovernmental Forum, May 2020

The Municipality of Jasper and the Parks Canada Agency in Jasper National Park are committed to a positive, mutually beneficial relationship based on shared goals and interests. To this end, representatives from the two organizations as well as mayor and council meet three to four times per year to discuss and advance topics of mutual interest. The May 26, 2020 Intergovernmental Forum highlights include:

Relaunch Plans

- Parks Canada and the Municipality of Jasper met to share relaunch plans and ensure both organizations are aligned and coordinated in their approach. While visitor services in Jasper National Park are still suspended, and the community continues to put appropriate safety measures in place, visitors will be able to begin to safely return to Jasper in early June.
- More information on relaunch plans will be communicated with the public in coming days and weeks. Both organizations are committed to providing a safe and enjoyable experience for residents and visitors alike, following provincial and federal public health directives.
- Visitors will be encouraged to bring a COVID-19 kit which includes gloves, face masks and hand sanitizer, and to wear non-medical masks in public when it's difficult to maintain physical distancing of two metres at all times.
