



Municipality of Jasper Business Licence Conditions

Condition Code	
BLC1	The Licensee shall provide the Chief Licensing Inspector or his designate, on demand, a list of the rental vehicles in the Licensee's care and shall confirm in writing whether each such vehicle is rented or un-rented, or was rented or un-rented at any time specified by the Chief Licensing Inspector.
BLC2	The Licensee shall not park or allow to be parked any un-rented rental vehicle in his care in a public on-street or off-street parking stall between the hours of 10:00 pm and 2:00 am on any day during the effective period of his Licence.
BLC3	The Licensee shall prominently mark with the business' operating name or logo every vehicle used in the activities of the business.
BLC4	The Licensee shall not park or allow to be parked any vehicle marked with his business name or logo and larger than one-ton in the manufacturer's specified capacity, or larger than one ton in capacity when combined with any attached trailer, in any public on-street or off-street parking stall between the hours of 10:00 pm and 2:00 am on any day during the effective period of this Business Licence.
BLC5	This licence provides for the rental of only the one (1) room approved for such use by Parks Canada.
BLC6	This licence provides for the rental of only the two (2) room approved for such use by Parks Canada.
BLC7	This licence provides for the rental of only the three (3) room approved for such use by Parks Canada.
BLC8	The Licensee shall provide written receipts to all guests and shall retain copies of such receipts.
BLC9	The Licensee shall maintain a guest registration book and shall provide such book to the Chief Licensing Inspector on demand.
BLC10	The Licensee shall maintain a membership in an approved bed-and-breakfast or home accommodation association.
BLC11	The Licensee shall maintain at all times during the term of this Licence liability insurance in an amount not less than \$2,000,000.
BLC12	The Licensee shall at all times operate within the requirements of the National Fire Code, and all application Parks Canada regulations.
BLC13	The Licensee shall at all times operate within the requirements of applicable health and food handling regulations.
BLC14	The Licensee shall not park or allow to be parked any vehicle marked with his business name or logo and configured seating for nine passengers or more including the operator, in any public on-street or off-street parking stall between the hours of 10:00 pm and 2:00 am on any day during the effective period of this Business Licence.
BLC15	No fluids associated with or resulting from the carpet cleaning process shall be deposited into the Jasper Waste Water Treatment Plant in any location other than on-site at the plant.
BLC16	Seating capacity shall not exceed limits established in accordance with applicable federal or provincial regulation or legislation.
