

POLICY

ALBERTA MARGARET ATKINSON SCHOLARSHIP

Mr. James Henry Atkinson of Jasper bequeathed funds to the former Jasper School Board to establish a scholarship to a graduate of the Jasper Junior/Senior High School. The scholarship is dedicated to Mr. Atkinson's beloved wife, Alberta Margaret.

GUIDELINES

ALBERTA MARGARET ATKINSON SCHOLARSHIP

1. The Award
 - 1.1 The award will be derived from the interest earned on the principal balance of the previous year.
 - 1.2 The maximum award will not exceed the total interest earned in that year.
 - 1.3 Any unexpended interest will be re-invested and added to the principal.
 - 1.4 The Municipality of Jasper shall administer the fund by investing in guaranteed securities.
 - 1.5 Payment of the scholarship will be made on receipt of verification of the successful applicant's acceptance at a post-secondary institution in the applicable course related to the scholarship.
 - 1.6 Advertising for the scholarship will take place during August and September of each year.

PROCEDURES

ALBERTA MARGARET ATKINSON SCHOLARSHIP

1. Eligibility

To be eligible for consideration of the annual scholarship, candidates must meet the following criteria:

- 1.1 The applicant must be a graduate of the Jasper Junior/Senior High School, Jasper, Alberta and
- 1.2 Be a student in any year of Medicine or Dentistry (excluding pre-med), or
- 1.3 Be a student in second or subsequent years of study towards a degree or other advanced qualifications in Nursing or paramedical studies, or
- 1.4 Be a student in second or subsequent years of Engineering or Commerce, or
- 1.5 Be a student in first or subsequent years in Law school.

PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO STUDENTS IN MEDICAL STUDIES.

- 1.6 To be considered, applications must be submitted by October 1 to the Secretary, Jasper Education Scholarship Committee, PO Box 520, Jasper, AB TOE 1EO

2. Selection

- 2.1 The selection committee shall be the Jasper Education Scholarship Committee which shall consist of:
 - The Jasper representative elected to the Grande Yellowhead Regional Division #35 Board of Trustees
 - 1 staff member from each of the Jasper Elementary School and the Jasper Junior/Senior High School
 - A parent representative of each of the Parent Advisory Council and the School Advisory Council
- 2.2 The Secretary of the Jasper Education Scholarship Committee shall be the Administrative Officer of the Municipality of Jasper.
- 2.3 The Secretary shall call all meetings of the committee.

3. General

The committee administering the award may make suggestions for change in the scholarship guidelines and procedures by presenting proposals to Municipal Council who shall have the authority to make or reject any such changes proposed.
