Presentation Council received a verbal presentation from Acting Sgt. Ryan Gardiner, who advised
RCMP Report that he is still in an acting position. He introduced Cst. Keryluk who is in the acting
position of corporal. Cpl. Gardiner's report covered statistics on various areas of
responsibility including assaults, domestic violence, impaired driving, graffiti abatement,
crime reduction strategies, staffing levels, number of prisoners guarded. He also
indicated that when guards are not available, prisoners must be transported to Hinton.

Business CAO Peter Waterworth advised Council that the Rodeo committee has met with
Arising Parks Canada regarding an outdoor location for this year's rodeo, but Parks Canada
Jasper Rodeo is not able to provide an outdoor location at this time. Rodeo committee officials will
come back to Council at the May 20th 2014 regular meeting to discuss this year's rodeo
location.

Department Council received a verbal report from the CAO which covered the recently successful
Reports RFP conference held in Jasper and indicating that hosting such an event of this
CAO magnitude is a huge commitment of staff time and effort. Mr. Waterworth thanked all
of the staff, and suggested that this was a good example of partnerships across
the community.

Mr. Waterworth advised Council regarding the ongoing training in emergency situations
taking place, on the demographics for disabled people who want to work, meeting with
acting Minister of Municipal Affairs, temporary foreign workers programme, and gave
an update on the progress of the new library building, indicating that some issues still
have to be resolved but work is progressing.

Councillors' Reports Councillor Arsenault attended the following meetings: Library Board, Museum - three year plan coming to Council May 20th. Also attended ESAC meeting.

Councillor Kelleher-Empey attended the CFC and Investment Review Board meetings.

Deputy Mayor Nesbitt attended the Volunteer Recognition Banquet and handed out awards on behalf of the Mayor. Also met with other councillors and Acting Minister of Municipal Affairs Gary Weadick on resort funding, and meeting with Associate Minister of Services for People with Disabilities.

Councillor Wall also met with Acting Minister Weadick on resort funding, and joined the rest of council in a joint meeting with the councils of Banff and Canmore to discuss matters of mutual concern.

Councillor Wacko met with the Banff and Canmore councils, and also spoke with Bob Leggett, former Jasper Town Committee member, regarding improvements to the Japanese exhibit on the Connaught Drive median. Councillor Wacko reported that Bob Leggett from Vancouver Island has purchased a piece of yellow cedar for us for this project and will get it to Jasper at an appropriate time.

Mayor Ireland indicated that he has spoken with the Mayor of Hinton regarding the Temporary Foreign Worker programme, and with MP Rob Merrifield and other Jasper partners. The Mayor of Hinton will draft a letter and circulate it to all mayors in our area. The Mayor of Banff will take the letter to Ottawa for a meeting with Minister McKenny and the Parliamentary Secretary regarding the impact of the Temporary Foreign Workers programme on businesses in our communities.

CAO Peter Waterworth advised that the Chamber will be speaking with every Chamber member to get a clearer picture of what the impacts will be on the membership.

Information Items Council received, for information purposes, the Jasper Library's annual report. Director of Library Services Judy Krefting and Gail Henderson, Board Chairman, were present at the meeting to field any questions, if necessary.
