Jasper Library Upon request and in conjunction with a letter sent to Council by Dale Karpluck,

Board- Grant Chairperson of the Jasper Library Board, Ms. Thom, Mr. Templeton and Mrs. Cox reported to Council that the surplus from the 2016 Library Municipal Grant is \$21,362. The Board would like to use the unspent monies to pay for additional staff hours and extended benefits for library staff in 2017. During budget deliberations, the Board requested a 2017 Municipal Grant of \$188,745 for the aforementioned uses. The Board indicated it would

like to apply the \$21,362 to that request, reducing it to \$167,383 for 2017. Council

indicated it was satisfied with the information the Library Board provided and the matter would come back with other budget parking lot items at an upcoming meeting.

In response to a question from Councillor Nesbitt regarding the Jasper Recreation Complex Renovation presentation, Mr. Fercho informed Council that the presentation was for information purposes.

In response to a question from Mayor Ireland regarding the approval of a financial reviewer for the Jasper Library Board, Mr. Fercho informed Council that approval was given in 2016 and was not necessary this year.

**Bylaw Summary** 

Council received, for information purposes, a summary of bylaws currently in force in the Municipality, and those in their various stages of readings.

Requests for decision: Notice-400 Block Patricia Street parking lot expansion Mr. Fercho presented a notice of request for decision regarding an expansion of the 400 Block Patricia Street parking lot, recommending Council approve 12 to 14 new stalls; that Council approve the expenditure of \$210,620 in capital funds from the Parking Authority Restricted Reserve; and that Council approve the designation of three parking stalls to the Jasper Downtown Hostel. Should Council not approve the designation of the three stalls, they would be developed elsewhere in town upon approval from PDAC and Parks Canada. Council discussed the value of parking stalls, the possibility of paid parking, and the upcoming transportation management study. The matter will be back for decision at the next regular Council meeting, April 18, 2017.
