Information Update Jasper Intergovernmental Forum, May 2021

The Municipality of Jasper and the Parks Canada Agency in Jasper National Park are committed to a positive, mutually beneficial relationship based on shared goals and interests. To this end, representatives from the two organizations as well as mayor and council meet three to four times per year to discuss and advance topics of mutual interest. The May 4, 2021 Intergovernmental Forum highlights include:

Jasper National Park Draft Management Plan

- Parks Canada presented a draft of the Jasper National Park Management Plan, inviting formal feedback from municipal Council. Public consultation on the plan is open until July 7, 2021 through the following website: <https://www.letstalkmountainparks.ca/jasper>

Private Home Accommodations

- Council provided answers to Parks Canada's questions from October 2020 regarding the management of Private Home Accommodation (PHA). Jasper National Park and the Municipality of Jasper will continue to discuss this matter further at upcoming meetings.

Emergency Management Authority

- Jasper National Park and the Municipality of Jasper are working on finalizing an agreement to enable the Alberta Emergency Management Act to be in force in Jasper. A draft is currently being reviewed by legal counsel, and will be submitted to the Government of Alberta as soon as practicable.
