

WATER SLIDE



SAFETY INFORMATION



Follow attendant instructions or start signal; ensure exit area is clear



No head first entry



Slide feet first in a sitting position; keep arms and legs in at all times

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- No stopping, standing, or climbing on the slide
- Must be in a sitting position when exiting the slide into the receiving pool
- Exit receiving pool immediately after riding the slide; use stairs only
- Prior to using the water slide consult your doctor if you: are pregnant; have a medical condition including but not limited to heart disease, hypertension, seizures, diabetes, or obesity; over 65 years old; or have a medical condition requiring ongoing care of a physician

EMERGENCY INFORMATION

- Notify staff in the event of injury or emergency
- Fire alarms are located next to all emergency exits
- AED and emergency telephone are located at the front desk and in the first aid room
- 3 whistle blasts - clear the water slide or receiving pool immediately

SAFETY INFORMATION



No glasses, loose jewelry, keys, or other items; secure items before riding



Receiving pool water depth: 1.06m (3'6")



Children under 8 require active supervision at all times; caregivers must be 14 years or older, in the water, and within arm's reach

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Maximum rider weight: 300lbs (136kg)
- Minimum rider height: 4' (1.22m)
- Riders under 4' (1.22m) and children who have not passed the facility swim test must ride with a caregiver or have a caregiver assist them in the receiving pool
- Toys are not permitted on the slide or in the receiving pool
- Swimwear with exposed zippers, buckles, rivets, or metal pieces are not permitted
- Prior to using the water slide consult your doctor if you: are pregnant; have a medical condition including but not limited to heart disease, hypertension, seizures, diabetes, or obesity; over 65 years old; or have a medical condition requiring ongoing care of a physician

EMERGENCY INFORMATION

- Notify staff in the event of injury or emergency
- Fire alarms are located next to emergency exits
- AED and emergency telephone are located at the front desk and in the first aid room
- 3 whistle blasts - clear the water slide or receiving pool immediately
